The Town of Burlington held its regular monthly meeting on February 10, 2009 at the Town Hall.

Officers present: Ken Hockley, Larry Zeitner, Ken Cook, Wade Aagard and Doug Allen. Also present, Bruce Dooley, Melissa Chatwin, Ryan Olson, Shane Trotter, Jay Reynolds, Trent Aagard and Justin Aagard.

Mayor Kenneth Hockley called the meeting to order at 7:31 p.m.

The minutes of January 13, 2009 were read and reviewed by the Mayor and Council. Doug made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Larry, all were in favor.
