September 8, 2009

The Town of Burlington held its regular monthly meeting on September 8, 2009 at the Town Hall.

Officers present: Ken Hockley, Larry Zeitner, Ken Cook, Wade Aagard and Doug Allen. Also present, Bruce Dooley, Melissa Chatwin, Terry Stanworth, Julio Gutteriez, Ryan Olson, McKay Olson.

Mayor Kenneth Hockley called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

The minutes of August 11, 2009 and August 25, 2009 were read and reviewed by the Mayor and Council. Doug made a motion to approve, seconded by Larry, all were in favor.

The Town has \$237,005.74 in the General Fund \$1,292.48 in the Capitol Projects Fund, \$74,839.39 in the Water Fund, and \$19,546.48 in the Sewer Fund.

Doug made a motion to accept the vouchers as presented, seconded by Wade. Motion passed, all in favor.

The Mayor reported that Shane has sent in the plans for the SRTS grant and we should get final approval in two weeks. He also reported that the water truck we were looking at in Nevada is gone and he is in the process of looking for another truck.

Gordon Srygley is wondering if the Town will waive his \$8 a month water charge, after some discussion, the Mayor is going to look into who owns the property.

The Coordinator from Big Horn County Management asked if the council would be willing to give funds based on population size. The funds go to help with the pre-disaster program for the County, the funds would be based on population size and be \$300 for one year. The Council agreed it was a good program to fund.

Larry made a motion, seconded by Ken Cook to pass Ordinance 09-2 on the third and final read, all were in favor.

The council okayed the letter to send out to residents in regards to Ordinance 09-2.

Terry Stanworth asked the council if there was anything they could do about the mosquitoes. After some discussion, the council will send out letters to Town residents, about mosquito control for next year.

Julio Gutteriez came to address the council about the trailer that he bought for his lot in the Husky Addition. After discussion it was decided that he could move the trailer in but he has 3 months starting October 1st to have siding on the house.

In the Husky Addition, the dissolution of the Husky Homeowners Association was discussed, Ken Cook is going to talk to Chris Edwards and report back to the council next month about what he finds out.

There was nothing new to report in Water & Sewer, Roads & Ditches and Parks.

Larry asked the council if there was anything they could do about the abandoned vehicles and trailers in town.

Susan is going to apply for an energy efficient grant, Bruce is going to have Big Horn REA come out and do an energy audit to see what would qualify.

The Rec Board wanted to know if they could use a room to store sound equipment in, the council decided to let them use Bruce's office.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 9:50p.m. Larry made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Doug, all in favor. The next monthly meeting will be October 13, 2009, at 7:30 p.m., at the Town Hall.
