

TOWN OF BURLINGTON  
TOWN MEETING  
August 11, 2015

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM by Mayor Wade Aagard. Those present: Wade Aagard, Cortney Allen, Don Hibbert, Leonard Broederlow, Hannah Winters, Lee Allen and Wink Bennett. Quorum was met.

Also present were Tom Laidlaw and Kay Neves, representing Greybull Valley Irrigation District. Pledge was recited. Don moved to accept the Agenda. Leonard seconded. Passed.

Leonard moved to accept the minutes. Cortney seconded. Passed.

Cortney moved to accept the Vouchers. Don seconded. Passed.

Tom Laidlaw and Kay Neves expressed a desire to combine the raw water irrigation with the town billing. Tabled until next meeting.

Wink reported on the Mayor's Meeting, which was held in Deaver July 16. The next Mayor's Meeting will be hosted by Burlington in September.

Roads & Ditches: Streets have been graded. Lane 38 needs a little more work due to heavy truck traffic.

Parks: Discussion was held regarding replacing the sand with small gravel in the playground areas. More picnic tables may be ordered this fall.

Water and Sewer: No changes

Husky: Letters will be sent to individuals who have not cleaned up their lots, reminding them that they agreed to keep their property clear of weeds and debris. There are to be no unlicensed vehicles sitting on the lots. Street lights will be ordered.

Animal Control: Dogs still remain at large. Fines will be imposed on the offenders.

Recreation District: New member of the Recreation Department are Louise Card, Austin Allen, Emily Winters and Robin Allen. Paul Rasmussen remains on the Rec Board as representative of the School Board. Hannah Winters will be the Town Council representative to the Rec Board.

Old Business: A brief discussion was held regarding the Pioneer Days Celebration. There will be further discussion at a special council meeting to be held on August 20 at 7:30 PM at Town Hall.

New Business: It was unanimously decided to create a checking account for special events. The account shall be named "Special Events Account" and two signatures shall be required. A special savings account shall be created for the playground equipment. This shall be titled "Park Savings Account".

A Planning and Zoning Commission will be appointed. A meeting for this shall be held on August 18, 2015 at 7:30 at Town Hall. Don moved to fill out a Change Application regarding the zoning in Husky Phase III. Cortney seconded. Passed. Due to Chris Edwards retiring in October, a new attorney needs to be hired to represent the town. Cortney moved to hire Kent Richins from Worland. Hannah seconded. Passed. A Community Potluck Dinner will be held on August 29 at 6:30 PM at the city park. If the weather is uncooperative, it will be held at the Firehall.

Don moved to adjourn the meeting at 9:45 PM. Cortney seconded. Meeting was adjourned.
