Recreation District: The Rec Department agrees to purchase some tables and chairs with the Town matching their purchase. There will be a Christmas Tree lighting ceremony on November 27. Refreshments will be served, followed by a movie at the Fire Hall.

Old Business: Delinquent Water Bills were discussed.

New Business: Hunter Allen was present to represent the Senior Class regarding the upcoming Senior trip to Washington D.C. He asked if the town would be willing to support a television ad, as they have in the past. Tabled until next month. It was announced that Wink Bennett will be resigning from her position as Town Clerk as of January 1, 2016. Applications may be picked up at Town Hall, due by November 30. An ordinance was presented to change winter meeting times to 6:30 PM, with summer hours remaining at 7:30 PM. Don moved to adjourn the meeting at 9:15 PM. Cortney seconded. Passed.
