

TOWN OF BURLINGTON
TOWN MEETING
October 13, 2015

The meeting was called to order at 7:50 PM by Mayor Wade Aagard. Those present: Wade Aagard, Cortney Allen, Don Hibbert, Leonard Broederlow, Hannah Winters, Lee Allen and Wink Bennett. Quorum was met. Pledge was recited. Cortney moved to accept the Agenda with changes. Hannah seconded. Passed. Leonard moved to accept the previous minutes. Don seconded. Passed.

Cortney moved to accept the Vouchers. Don seconded. Passed.

Mayor's Report: Mayor Aagard reported that the Mayor's Meeting went well. Discussion was held regarding getting speed signs next year.

Clerk's Report: A new Bulletin Board has been ordered to replace the one at the Post Office.

Roads & Ditches: Streets will need to be graded before winter. Gravel needs to be hauled at the entrance to the burn pit that is between Broederlow's and Pioneer Automotive. A letter will be sent out in the Spring to remind citizens that it is their responsibility to keep weeds close to the sidewalk cut down.

Parks: Four more picnic tables will be purchased this fall.

Water and Sewer: Wink will check to see if there is an ordinance which refers unpaid water/sewer bills from the renter back to the landlord.

Husky: The vote was unanimous to leave the prices of Husky Lots the same for ½ and ¼ acre lots at \$15,600 and \$7800, respectively-with the exception that lots that are sold for Twin Homes or duplexes shall be sold for \$16,600. Don moved to sell the lots at these prices. Cortney seconded. Passed.

Animal Control: An informational meeting will be held on November 10 at 6:30 PM regarding the issue of feral cats in town. Posters will be placed in various locations, it will be posted in the school newsletter and will be put on the October water bills. Cortney moved. Leonard seconded. Passed

Recreation District: The suggestion was made that perhaps the Rec Department could purchase some tables and chairs with the Town matching their purchase. The Rec Dept wishes to have a Christmas Tree Lighting Ceremony on December 6. Discussion was held regarding putting lights on Town Hall.

Old Business: Discussion was held regarding the use of Jake Brakes by trucks going through town and putting more street lights on Main Street.

New Business: A draft of the Agenda and Minutes shall be emailed to all members on the Monday before each meeting. Leonard moved to accept the WYOWARN agreement. Hannah seconded. Passed. Wade asked about building a studio apartment above his shop.

Cortney moved to adjourn the meeting. Leonard seconded. Meeting was adjourned at 9:50 PM.
