

TOWN OF BURLINGTON
TOWN MEETING
July 12, 2016

The meeting was called to order at 7:39 PM by Mayor Wade Aagard. Those present: Wade Aagard, Hannah Winters, Leonard Broederlow, Don Hibbert, Lee Allen and Mallory Owen. Quorum met.

Citizens' Participation: Sheriff Blackburn came to discuss with the council some options for the town to have cops patrol the town a few hours a week.

David Wardell came to discuss his Eagle Project at Aagard Park replacing the fence. The town is going to remove the trees, and David is going to put up a new chain link fence.

Weston Neves also came to discuss his Eagle Project at Aagard Park. He will be working with Lee to get the correct design and measurements to get the new sign ordered.

Mayor's Report: Wade Aagard discussed his concerns for a side x side. He feels a golf cart/utility ATV that is more heavy duty but slower would be better and safer for the town employees.

Clerk's Report: Mallory Owen talked about the benefit of ordering different checks for the Recreation Department.

Roads and Ditches: Council discussed the need for branches that have been blown off trees around the town that need to be picked up and taken care of.

Parks: Council discussed the water pump, sprinklers, and fittings having to be replaced at Aagard Park. It was also discussed the need for new sand to be brought into the parks play areas.

Water and Sewer: Lee Allen discussed water usages still being higher but said they are matching with last year's usages.

Husky: Council discussed the need for lights to be checked to make sure all are working.

Animal Control: Lee discussed that trapping is still going well. It was also brought up that there are dogs running loose around the town.

Recreation District: Hannah Winters discussed the need for more entries for the Pioneer Day's parade are needed. Please contact Robin Allen to make an entry.

New Business: Don Hibbert brought up the need to help the county find a place to store the road grader. The council agreed and would like to come up with a location that would keep the grader in town.

Old Business: Pioneer Day planning meeting at 7:30pm Thursday July 14, 2016. Council encourages all to attend. Council also discussed the finishing touches that need to be made for the TAP (Transportation Alternatives Program). Grant that needs to be in Friday July 15, 2016. Council talked about calling Big Horn REA and having them install a light by the fire hall to help create a safer street.

There being no further business Don motioned to adjourn the meeting Hannah 2nd the motion. Passed. Meeting adjourned at 9:57 pm.
