Animal Control: Chipping for your cats is available for \$35 on Free Cat Licensing day if you let us know ahead of time so we can get them ordered.

Old Business: WAM Convention being held in February. Council also discussed changing from Security State Bank to Bank of Greybull and moving all town funds to the Bank Of Greybull. Mayor Wade Aagard and Council member Don Hibbert will have to go to the Bank Of Greybull to sign signature cards. Cortney motioned to proceed to change to Bank Of Greybull Don 2nd motion Passed.

New Business: There will be a free cat licensing day on January 28, 2016 from 10am to 12pm.
