TOWN MEETING
March 8, 2016

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM by Mayor Wade Aagard. Those present: Wade Aagard, Cortney Allen, Leonard Broederlow, Hannah Winters, and Mallory Owen. Quorum met. Others present: Josh Basset from Roadrunner Sanitation, and John Joyce. Cortney motioned to approve the Agenda. Hannah second. Passed. Leonard motioned to accept previous minutes. Hannah second. Citizens' Participation: John Joyce came and presented the Greybull River Road Expansion Project Proposal, and invited the Town to be part of the project.

Josh Bassett came and talked to the town about clean up day. Roadrunner now has roll off capability and would like to provide garbage service for the cleanup day.

Mayor's Report: Mayor Wade Aagard discussed the town purchasing water meter covers with a cap to protect the meters and keep the bottoms from rotting off. He also discussed the need for a Rec. Department position needing to be filled.

Clerk's Report: Nothing to report.

Roads and Ditches: Council discussed how nice it was to have some roads graded and smoothed out, and water put on them to cut down on the dust. It was also discussed that some of our roadsides and ditches are being used for excess dirt, and garbage. Council would like to keep our town looking nice so please clean up after your projects.

Parks: Council discussed the need for bigger trees to be trimmed down so that branches wouldn't fall or get into power lines.

Water and Sewer: Council discussed purchasing a little more land around the sewer lagoon to be able to start our sprinkle treated water project, and begin to grow grass and new trees. Council also discussed setting aside funds to be able to purchase GIS System.

Husky: Lights are coming soon! Council also discussed setting up a town website of the Husky Division which would contain pictures of what people would be purchasing, costs of the lots, and all the great things our small community has to offer.

Animal Control: Cat catching is going very well and town was very pleased with the amount of cats we have gotten licensed.

Recreation District: Council discussed at next month's meeting having members of the Rec. Board come and join the town council to discuss things going on, any issues questions, or planning events to help keep everyone informed. The Rec. is also working on getting an application for funding for new park equipment

Old Business: Council discussed town employees using direct deposit. Cortney motioned to accept direct deposits for employees. Hannah second. Passed

New Business: The town is signing a contract with the REA for lights in the Husky Division.

There being no further business Leonard motioned to adjourn the meeting Cortney 2nd motion. Passed. Meeting adjourned at 8:50pm.
