TOWN MEETING  
November 8, 2016

The meeting was called to order at 6:34 PM by Mayor Wade Aagard. Those present: Wade Aagard, Hannah Winters, Don Hibbert, Leonard Broederlow, Lee Allen and Mallory Owen. Quorum met.

Agenda, Vouchers and previous minutes were approved and passed.

Citizens' Participation: Aerial Ferret came and advocated for the senior class in asking for donations for their senior trip. Council discussed and decided to donate what the town donated last year.

Clerk's Report: None

Discussion was held regarding the Sheriff's patrolling activities. The town has been approved for a TAP sidewalk grant.

Roads and Ditches: Culverts have been purchased to assist drainage in Husky. Gravel has be put on Farmer Street and will be put in other places around town as needed. The county accepted the town's offer to store the county grader in exchange for grading Poplar Avenue.

Parks: 8 trees have been planted in Aagard Park. Dead trees have been removed. Leaves will be removed from parks as soon as the vacuum for the mower is fixed.

Water and Sewer: Discussion was held regarding replacing some of the older water meters in town. Burning will be done at the sewer lagoon.

Husky: The website will soon be up and running and options for advertising lot sales were discussed.

Animal Control: ALL animals are required to be on a leash if they are not contained on your property. Please observe the ordinance!!! This is will be enforced!

Recreation District: The annual Christmas tree lighting will take place November 26. Purchase of the Srygley property is not being considered as an option for Rec Department development.

New Business: Discussion was held regarding obtaining an easement for town use of the drain to prevent flooding in Matt Davidson's basement.

Old Business: Discussion was held regarding Mike Aagard's offer to allow the burn pit to be moved to his property in exchange for water. Cleanup needs to be done at the shop with the removal of certain items. Grass will be cut. Discussion was held regarding putting Christmas decorations in front of Town Hall.

There being no further business Don motioned to adjourn the meeting Hannah 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Passed. Meeting adjourned at 8:24 PM.
