

TOWN OF BURLINGTON
TOWN MEETING
February 16, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM by Mayor Wade Aagard. Those present: Wade Aagard, Jerry George, Don Hibbert, Leonard Broederlow, Lee Allen and Mallory Owen. Quorum met.

Agenda, Vouchers and previous minutes were approved and passed.

Mayor's Report: Mayor Wade Aagard commented on how the new culverts in Husky were draining with all the water runoff.

Clerks Report: Mallory Owen reported that due to the ice jams near Basin, Manderson, and Greybull, LaRae Dobbs who is the Big Horn County Emergency Management Coordinator would have to reschedule coming to meet with the council.

Roads and Ditches: Council discussed as snow melts and roads begin to soften it would be good to get the grader out to clean up pot holes and smooth out the roads.

Parks: Council discussed everything is going well with the parks, as soon as spring and summer come Eagle Scout projects will pick back up.

Water and Sewer: Lee discussed the large amounts of ice in the water tanks. Lee also reported that the increased water flows we've seen this winter, to prevent frozen pipes, is filling the sewer lagoon faster than normal and will cause him to release water from the lagoons earlier this spring.

Husky: Council discussed advertising in the paper and on face book to let people know of the town lots for sale.

Animal Control: Everything is going well.

Recreation District: The recreation department is trying to plan out activities for the next 6 months to give people time to plan into their schedules. Council also discussed the idea of a splash pad being built.

New Business: Council discussed building permits and Don motioned to amend building ordinance permits. Jerry 2nd Passed. Council also discussed idea used to help with our financial audit. Lee brought a record keeping resolution that needed to be signed for sidewalk grant. Jerry motioned to adopt record keeping resolution. Don 2nd passed. WAM had sent a Wyoming Gun Free Zone Act and asked council to send their vote back to legislature; Jerry motioned to respond to Wyoming Gun Free Zone Act and vote that we should have more local control. Don 2nd motion was passed.

Old Business: Council discussed the need to start advertising our husky lots that are for sale in the buyers guide, local papers and Facebook. Council also discussed that hopefully by the end of the month the cameras will be moved to a new location. Council also discussed remodel of town bathrooms, council would like to make them handicapped accessible.

There being no further business Don Hibbert motioned to adjourn the meeting Jerry 2nd the motion passed. Meeting adjourned at 8:50 PM.
