TOWN MEETING  
May 9, 2017

Old Business: Council discussed the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading of the 2017-2018 budget, Cortney Allen motioned to pass 2<sup>nd</sup> reading of the budget, Jerry George 2<sup>nd</sup>, motion passed.
