October 11, 2017

Correspondence, Reports & Information: Wade reported on renewing contract with LDS FM Group for snow removal for the Burlington LDS Church.

Citizens Participation: Stephanie Brown came and discussed grant options. Council talked about what they felt were top priorities for the town. Don Hibbert motioned to hire Stephanie for 1 year with a cap of \$3,000.00 to find and write grants, Jenny Booth 2nd, motion passed. Dave Shultz came and talked with council about how the TAP Grant was going, and things the State would like changed. Council agreed to make minor changes.

Mayors Report: Wade discussed if the town was still interested in doing snow removal for the Burlington LDS Church.

Clerks Report: Nothing to report.

Roads and Ditches: Lee contacted WYDOT and they should be coming soon to fix the broken speed limit sign in the middle of town.

Parks: Council commented on how great Aagard Park is looking. Lee discussed he added 20min to each zone and it helped the grass green right up.

Water/Sewer: Lee talked to council about doing 3 flow tests on hydrants in town. With the results of tests should help cost of insurance go down.

Animal Control: Council had 3rd and final reading on Ordinance 17-03. It was also discussed the need to purchase signs to let visitors and new town members that we have a leash law.

Recreation District: Council made a few changes to the Recreation District Guidelines, Don motioned to approve the changes to the guidelines, Jerry 2nd, motion passed.

New Business: Council discussed making sure the checks to the groups that helped with the Pioneer Day Celebration.

Old Business: Jerry motioned to approve 2nd reading of raising water/sewer rates, Cortney 2nd the motion, motion passed.

There being no further business Don Hibbert motioned to adjourn the meeting Cortney second, motion passed. Meeting adjourned at 10:16 PM.
