TOWN MEETING
September 12, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 7:35 PM by Mayor Wade Aagard. Those present: Wade Aagard, Don Hibbert, Jerry George, Cortney Allen, Jenny Booth, Lee Allen and Mallory Owen. Full Quorum.

Agenda, Vouchers and previous minutes were approved and passed.

Correspondence, Reports & Information: Don motioned for Wade to sign the Constitution Proclamation Jerry second, motion passed. Council discussed having a work meeting on September 26th at 6:30pm to discuss Recreation Guidelines, Grant Priorities, and setting up and employee evaluations.

Citizens Participation: Carter Patrowski came and discussed a culvert that is in need of being replaced. Brian Neves came and talked to the town about the possibility of opening a veterinarian clinic up in Burlington. The council was supportive of the idea. Jessie Hamilton came and discussed his building plan with the town to get a building permit.

Mayors Report: Wade Aagard discussed the Recreation District Distribution meeting. Burlington's Recreation Budget will remain the same.

Clerks Report: Mallory reported a Microsoft Excel Class in Billings that she would like to attend.

Roads and Ditches: Lee Allen gave an update on how the TAP Grant (sidewalk) was going. Council discussed contacting WYDOT about speed limit sign needing to be put back up in the middle of town.

Parks: Council discussed the Eagle Projects that were about finished in Aagard Park. They also discussed possible projects that needed to be done that could be used Eagle Scout Projects.

Water/Sewer: Lee talked about the inspectors that came to check out our water system and water tanks. Council discussed getting bids to have people come and inspect the tanks and if needed to clean them.

Husky: Council discussed a few people who have contacted the town several times and are interested in purchasing a lot. Council discussed since the new culverts were installed the water has been running great and much cleaner.

Animal Control: Council discussed the changes that were made to Animal Ordinance 17-03. Don motioned to accept the new changes and to approve the 2nd reading, Jerry 2nd the motion. Motion Passed.

Recreation District: Wade discussed needing to find a replacement for Otto Recreation Board Member. Holly Michaels was brought up as a possible replacement option. Council agreed she would be great. Jerry motioned to approve school district # 1 contract with the town, Cortney 2nd motion passed.

Cortney motioned to go into executive session to discuss employees. Jerry 2nd the motion. Motion passed.

There being no further business Don Hibbert motioned to adjourn the meeting Cortney second, motion passed. Meeting adjourned at 10:16 PM.
